Connor held as bail jumper at Charles St.

Myles J. Connor Jr. of Milton is being held in the Charles Street Jail pending arraignment in US District Court for jumping bail and failing to appear for trial last April.

Connor was arrested in South Hadley last Friday by FBI agents. He was armed with an automatic pistol when he was picked up, agents said.

The 32-year-old rock n' roll performer failed to appear last April 22 before Chief Judge Andrew A. Caffrey in connection with the theft of \$165,000 in paintings, including works of Andrew Wyeth, from the Woolworth estate in Monmouth, Me.

Connor was arrested for that theft in Mashpee in July, 1974.

Agents said they had been keeping the South Hadley home of a friend of Connor under surveillance since learning the suspect had recently been in Canada and planned to stop there.

Seized on the fugitive warrant, Connor was accused of receiving stolen property in interstate commerce. He also faces revocation of his parole from Walpole State Prison, where he served a sentence for the wounding of State Police Lt. Col. John O'Donovan during a gun battle in a Back Bay apartment house in 1966.
