

Three sentenced to prison in arson at Medford firm

Three men were sentenced to 4 to 8 years at Walpole State Prison yesterday after a Middlesex Superior Court jury found

them guilty of the burning of a Medford laundry a year ago. They were sentenced by Judge John P. Sullivan.

Found guilty of arson were Leonard J. Piazza, 45, of Summer street, Lynn; Frank E. Imbruglia, 42, of Vallon road, East Boston and Robert A. Donati, 33, of Winthrop street, Everett.

Donati's sentence will become effective after he serves a portion of a 12-20 year sentence for armed robbery. He was on parole on this charge at the time of the fire.

Assistant Dist. Atty. John Kivlan presented several members of the Medford Police Dept. who testified they saw the defendants enter the Deluxe Laundry at 522 Main st., Medford and other officers who saw them leaving the building.
