

3 Held in Bail In \$41,000 Holdup Of Hub Furrier

Three men indicted Tuesday on three charges of armed robbery in the Back Bay pleaded innocent today before Judge Vincent R. Brogna in Suffolk Superior Court.

The Suffolk County Grand Jury returned indictments against Anthony Zirpolo, 28, of Leyden st., East Boston; Robert Donati, 21, of Marion st., East Boston; and Christopher G. Brown (alias Frank Soccori), 54, no permanent address, in connection with the \$41,000 fur robbery from Huerth and Huerth, Boylston st., two weeks ago.

● the result of a parking ticket
● put on the alleged getaway car.

Judge Brogna today set bail at \$25,000 for each man, and gave Atty. Alfred Farese 15 days to prepare special pleas, with trial to be set at that time.
