Art theft plea given

Brian Michael McDevitt, 21, of Swampscot, Mass., pleaded guilty Friday to charges stemming from a plot to steal art from the Hyde Museum, Glens Falls, last December.

McDevitt and Michael B. Morey, 30, of Queensbury, were originally indicated on charges of second-degree kidnapping and second-degree robbery. They were charged with abducting a Federal Express driver at gunpoint and using her truck to rob the Hyde.

Morey recently pleaded to reduced charges of attempted robbery and was sentenced to 60 days in the Saratoga County jail and placed on five years' probation.
