3 men accused in Medford fire

Three men were arrested by two Medford police sergeants last night shortly before a fire of suspicious origin gutted the Deluxe Shirt Cleaners plant on Main street in South Medford.

Sgt. Richard McGlynn and Sgt. Paul Reardon said they observed two men leaving the shop, closed for the night, at 7:15 p.m. and arrested them. A third man in a nearby car was also arrested.

Minutes later, the shop burst into flames, fire officials said. The flames were spurred by four pots of flammable liquid. The blaze caused an estimated \$30,000 damage.

Charged with arson and conspiracy to commit arson are Frank E. Imbruglia, 42, of 1 Valla rd., East Boston; Leonard J. Piazza, 44, of 832 Summer st., Lynn; and Robert A. Donati, 32, of 75 Winthrop st., Everett.

The three men are scheduled to be arraigned this morning in Malden District Court.
